

There Is Coming A Day When Egyptians Will Speak Like Jews

“In that day shall Egypt be like unto women: and it shall be afraid and fear because of the shaking of the hand of the LORD of hosts, which he shaketh over it. And the land of Judah shall be a terror unto Egypt, every one that maketh mention thereof shall be afraid in himself, because of the counsel of the LORD of hosts, which he hath determined against it. **In that day shall five cities in the land of Egypt speak the language of Canaan...**”

Isaiah 19:16-18

Isaiah's Prophecy Of Egypt

Isaiah 19:1-15 reveals an **8-fold judgment of Egypt** because of their unbelief in Jehovah God of Israel. There is coming a day when Egypt will experience civil strife and disorder. They will suffer despair and hopelessness, as well as political and spiritual confusion. Sounds a lot like today, doesn't it?

Isaiah reveals **3 specific future judgments** that God will unleash upon the nation of Egypt:

- **Isaiah 19:2** - “And I will set the Egyptians against the Egyptians: and they shall fight every one against his brother, and every one against his neighbour; city against city, and kingdom against kingdom.”

- **Isaiah 19:3** - “And the spirit of Egypt shall fail in the midst thereof; and I will destroy the counsel thereof: and they shall seek to the idols, and to the charmers, and to them that have familiar spirits, and to the wizards.”

- **Isaiah 19:4** - “And the Egyptians will I give over into the hand of a cruel lord; and a fierce king shall rule over them, saith the Lord, the LORD of hosts.”

While we see similarities of the first two judgments coming to pass today, I believe they will worsen in the land of Egypt. During the Tribulation, the Beast will arise, and Egypt will fall under his rule. This same fierce king (Antichrist) is prophesied by Daniel, as well.

We find his prophecy in **Daniel 8:23**: “And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up.”

In That Day

It is interesting to note that **SIX (6) TIMES** God uses the phrase, “**IN THAT DAY,**” to describe His dealings with Egypt during the Tribulation. Let us examine each of them.



Egypt Will Be Afraid & Fear

Isaiah 19:16 – “In that day shall Egypt be like unto women: and it shall be afraid and fear because of the shaking of the hand of the LORD of hosts, which he shaketh over it.”

God will pour out Divine judgment upon the nation of Egypt. It is possible that such judgments revealed in **Isaiah 19:1-15** have already begun, and if so, they will certainly intensify during the “**Time of Jacob's Trouble.**”

Egypt Will Speak Like Jews

Isaiah 19:18 – “In that day shall five cities in the land of Egypt speak the language of Canaan...”

Isaiah's prophecy reveals something quite interesting. Isaiah says there is coming a day when Egyptians will speak like Jews! What is the **language of Canaan**? It is **HEBREW** and Hebrew is the language of the **JEWS!**

Egypt Will Have An Altar

Isaiah 19:19 – “In that day shall there be an altar to the LORD in the midst of the land of Egypt, and a pillar at the border thereof to the LORD.”

We should understand that the prominent religion of Egypt is Islam, and Islam does not promote sacrificial worship. So why will Muslims have an “altar to the Lord”?

The answer is found in **Isaiah 19:20** – “And it shall be for a **sign** and for a **witness unto the LORD of hosts** in the land of Egypt:” **IN THAT DAY** some Egyptians will forsake their current beliefs and turn to the One and Only True God – **Jehovah God of Israel!**

Egypt Will Offer Sacrifices

Isaiah 19:21 – “And the LORD shall be known to Egypt, and the Egyptians shall know the LORD in that day, and shall do sacrifice and oblation; yea, they shall vow a vow unto the LORD, and perform it.”

Not only will Egypt have an altar to the Lord, but they will use the altar to offer sacrifice and oblation unto the Lord God.

Egypt Will Be Sanctified

Isaiah 19:23 – “In that day shall there be a highway out of Egypt to Assyria, and the Assyrian shall come into Egypt, and the Egyptian into Assyria, and the Egyptians shall serve with the Assyrians.”

Both Egypt and Assyria will be sanctified by God. Notice that **IN THAT DAY** both will serve together

Egypt Will Be A Blessing

Isaiah 19:24-25 – “In that day shall Israel be the third with Egypt and with Assyria, even a blessing in the midst of the land: Whom the LORD of hosts shall bless, saying, Blessed be Egypt my people, and Assyria the work of my hands, and Israel mine inheritance.”

What a rare verse of Scripture! Israel, Egypt, and Assyria all mentioned favorably in the same verse! God calls Egypt – **His People**. God calls Assyria – **The Work of His Hand**. God calls Israel – **His Inheritance**. That’s what **GOD’S GRACE** can do – It can turn **SINNERS** into **SAINTS**.

Will YOU bow your head right now and pray, “Lord Jesus, I acknowledge I am a sinner, and I repent of my sin. I believe JESUS (Yeshua) died for my sins but rose from the dead to conquer death and hell. I call upon YESHUA (JESUS) now and ask you to deliver me. In the name of JESUS I pray, AMEN!
