

JEREMIAH 30:7 “Alas! for that day is great, so that none is like it; it is even the time of Jacob’s trouble; but he shall be saved out of it.”

ZECHARIAH 14:2 “For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.”

Messiah to deliver them, and JESUS will deliver them!

ROMANS 11:26-27 “And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob. For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.”

**ISRAEL’S DESOLATE
HOUSE**

“O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not! Behold, your house is left unto you desolate. For I say unto you, Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord.”

These are the words of Yeshua (Jesus) before He was crucified on Calvary. Notice the tiny word “till”. There are “4 UNTILS” that must come to pass before the Coming of Yeshua (Jesus) to set up His Kingdom on this earth.

“ UNTIL THE TIMES OF THE GENTILES BE FULFILLED”

LUKE 21:24 “And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, UNTIL the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled.”

The Jewish people have been the most persecuted people in history. Throughout their history, they have suffered at the hands of Gentile powers, especially since the siege of Jerusalem by Babylon. However, Yeshua warned Israel that they would be led away into all nations (not just Babylon as in 586 BC). Following His crucifixion, Jerusalem would be trodden down of the Gentiles.

History bears record that this began when Romans soldiers marched upon the city of Jerusalem and destroyed the Jewish Temple in AD 70. Since then, Jews have been scattered

throughout the world.

We are living in the Times of the Gentiles. More Jews live outside of Israel, Jerusalem is a source of controversy and contention, and the Jewish people are still persecuted and ridiculed by Gentile nations worldwide.

So when will the Times of the Gentiles be fulfilled? It will not be fulfilled until the Time of Jacob’s Troubles (Tribulation) comes to a close.

“UNTIL THE FULNESS OF THE GENTILES BE COME IN”

ROMANS 11:25 “For I would not, brethren, that ye should not be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, “UNTIL the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.”

After the rejection of Yeshua HaMashiach (Jesus the Messiah), God Divinely judged the Jewish nation. National Israel has been “removed from God’s favor” and placed under the spirit of slumber. This is revealed in Romans 11.

ROMANS 11:8 “(According as it is written, God hath given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear;) unto this day.”

ROMANS 11:25 “...that blindness in part is happened to Israel, UNTIL the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.”

This does NOT mean that God has forsaken Israel, His chosen people. Rather, God

is offering salvation to the Gentiles in order to provoke the Jews to jealousy, and ultimately bring them to receive Yeshua, their Messiah.

ROMANS 11:11 “I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall? God forbid: but rather through their fall salvation is come unto the Gentiles, for to provoke them to jealousy.”

The RICHES OF THE WORLD and the RICHES OF THE GENTILES refer to the age in which we now live – The CHURCH AGE.

The FULNESS OF THE GENTILES will be the conclusion of the Church Age, which of course, culminates at the RAPTURE.

Before the Second Coming of Messiah, the Rapture of the Church must occur, then Israel’s blindness will be lifted and the events the Tribulation which follow will lead the Jews to receive Yeshua.

“UNTIL ISRAEL ACKNOWLEDGES ITS OFFENCE & SEEKS GOD’S FACE”

HOSEA 5:15 “I will go and return to my place, TILL they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: in their affliction will they seek me early.”

Following the Fulness of the Gentiles (Rapture), the Time of Jacob’s Troubles will commence. This seven year period of tribulation will be a terrible time of judgment upon the inhabitants of the earth.
