ISRAEL'S PRAYER FOR DELIVERANCE

"DO UNTO THEM AS UNTO THE MIDIANITES"

JUDGES 7 reveals how Midian was defeated by Gideon's vastly outnumbered army when God turned the Midianite army against each other.

"DO UNTO THEM AS UNTO SISERA"

Sisera commanded the mighty Canaanite army, but he was defeated by a woman named Jael when she drove a tent peg through his head (JUDGES 4).

"DO UNTO THEM AS UNTO OTHER ENEMIES"

Israel prays that God will destroy ALL of the armies that come against them as He

has defeated their enemies in the past. They will ask the Most High God to cause their enemies to perish for all their evil!

"WHY DOES GOD ALLOW SUCH AN ATTACK?"

I believe the answer is found in **PSALM 83:18** – "That men may know that thou, whose name alone is JEHOVAH, art the most high over all the earth."

DO YOU KNOW THE MOST HIGH GOD?

Will YOU bow your head right now and pray, "Lord Jesus, I acknowledge I am a sinner, and I repent of my sin. I believe JESUS (Yeshua) died for my sins but rose from the dead to conquer death and hell. I call upon YESHUA (JESUS) now and ask you to deliver me. In the name of JESUS I pray, AMEN!

PSALM 83: ISRAEL'S PRAYER FOR DELIVERANCE

PSALM 83:1-4 “A Song or Psalm of Asaph. Keep not thou silence, O God: hold not thy peace, and be not still, O God. For, lo, thine enemies make a tumult: and they that hate thee have lifted up the head. They have taken crafty counsel against thy people, and consulted against thy hidden ones. They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation; that the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance.”

An ancient prophecy written over 3000 years ago reveals that the Arab states and terrorist populations, which presently share common borders with Israel, will soon confederate in order to wipe Israel off of the map. This scenario has never been so close to being fulfilled. Should Israel be concerned?

“ISRAEL’S PLEA”

In **Psalm 83:1-4**, we find an end-time plea of the Jewish people of Israel. “They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation, That the name of Israel may be remembered no more” (Psalm 83:4).

While many of today’s Bible experts predict that Russia, Iran, Turkey, Libya, and several other countries will invade Israel according to Ezekiel 38-39, this timely prophecy in Psalm 83 explains how another attack on the nation of Israel will occur prior.

Mahmoud Ahmadinejad of Iran recently stated, “Israel ought to be wiped off the face of the earth!” He has said, “The existence of the Zionist regime is an insult to all humanity!” Hassan Nasrallah (Hezbollah) has publically gone on record as saying, “We can transform the lives of millions of Zionists in occupied

Palestine to a real hell!” Khaled Meshaal (Hamas), said, “It is time for you (Israelis) to be gone. Live wherever you like, but don’t live among us! It is time for you to be gone. Die wherever you like, but don’t die among us!”

Many Muslim children are taught to hate Jews simply because they are Jewish. Hundreds of school children in Gaza recently graduated a course in military training aimed specifically to inflict terror against the State of Israel.

The black flag of Islam, called ar-Raya, has now become the latest symbol of unity among Muslim fundamentalists. It is said that Muhammad, the so-called “prophet” and founder of Islam, carried a black flag into battle, made from a piece of cloth that was wrapped around the head of his child-bride, Aisha. This flag is referred to as al-Uqab, “the Eagle” or “the Punishment.”

✓ Jewish citizens of Israel have plenty of reasons to be concerned. **The PROPHECY OF PSALM 83** could come to pass at any time. If the enemies of Israel decide to act confederate against Israel, a devastating war would ensue. There are approximately 250 million Arabs surrounding just 6 million Jews in Israel.

According to Psalm 83, this war is not just a possibility; it will be a reality!

“ISRAEL’S PROBLEM”

PSALM 83:5-8 “For they have consulted together with one consent: they are confederate against thee: The tabernacles of Edom, and the Ishmaelites; of Moab, and the Hagarenes; Gebal, and Ammon, and Ama-

lek; the Philistines with the inhabitants of Tyre; Assur also is joined with them: they have holpen the children of Lot. Selah.”

The division between Hamas and the Fatah, have prevented a massive uprising against the Jewish population. However, in recent months, attempts have been made to “mend the fences” separating these two Arab Muslim factions. Iran has tried to bolster its influence in Syria, Iraq, Egypt, and other Arab nations. Is this a sign that the Arab world is becoming “CONFEDERATE” against Israel?

“We will never recognize the legitimacy of the Israeli occupation and therefore there is no legitimacy for Israel, no matter how long it will take” (Hamas leader Khaled Meshaal).

The rising confidence of Hamas militants in the Gaza Strip, combined with rapidly deteriorating relations with Israel’s would-be peace partner in the West Bank, are raising jitters in Israel that a new Palestinian uprising could be near.

The Arab Confederacy listed in **PSALM 83:5-8** refers to nations that surround Israel from Saudi Arabia to Jordan; from Syria to Lebanon; from Gaza to Egypt. Israel is surrounded by countries that do not wish them well.

“ISRAEL’S PRAYER”

PSALM 83:9-18 “Do unto them as unto the Midianites; as to Sisera, as to Jabin, at the brook of Kison... Make their nobles like Oreb, and like Zeeb: yea, all their princes as Zebah, and as Zalmunna...
